The OECD is one of the leading international organisations striving for an enhanced use of innovative and sustainable technologies.

With the regularly published OECD Environmental Outlook Report the OECD creates a globally unique basis for combating the most urgent challenges: climate change, loss of diversity of species, water shortage, and health. These are fields for which modern environmental technology can provide decisive answers.

In May 2008 a Memorandum of Understanding was signed in San Francisco between the Ministry of Life and the US State California. It aims at intensifying the exchange of information in the fields of environmental technology, climate protection, energy efficiency, and renewable energies, environmentally compatible building, and waste and water management, and at encouraging co-operations at scientific and technological levels.

Due to the progressive environmental legislation in California, California is an interesting market for Austrian products and know-how in the environmental technology sector.
